We supply these items free of charge by engaging and connecting communities that have with communities that need.

- Collection: Cradles to Crayons collects new and nearly new children's items through grassroots community and corporate drive donations.
- Processing: Over 1,000 volunteers individuals, families, community and corporate groups - come to Cradles to Crayons each month to sort, inspect and prepare customized packs of everyday essentials.
- Distribution: KidPacks each containing a week's worth of everyday essentials - are distributed by more than 260 social service agencies to low-income and homeless children living in the Greater Philadelphia region.

Why We Are Needed

- Poverty among children is the highest in 50 years.
- 1 in 5 children, over 190,000 children in total, live in poverty in the Greater Philadelphia region.
- Poverty has increased by 57% in the suburbs since 2002.

Who We Serve

- Low-income and homeless children from ages 0-12 around the Greater Philadelphia region, including Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery and Philadelphia counties, and in Camden, New Jersey.
- We partner with a wide range of social service agencies, including homeless and domestic violence shelters, schools, and foster homes that provide direct assistance to children.
- These distribution partners order supplies online from Cradles to Crayons for individual children in their care and pick them up from our warehouse a few days
